## Andrew Johnson National Historic Site & Visitor's Center

9:00am until 5:00pm | Daily (except Christmas & Thanksgiving)

The Site honors the life of the 17th President. Andrew Johnson's presidency, 1865-1869, illustrates the United States Constitution at work following President Lincoln's assassination and during his attempts to reunify a nation torn by civil war. On the home front, learn how the President's family became involved in their community and how a single illness changed the direction of their lives.

Tours of the Visitor's Center and Early Homestead are self-guided. Guided tours of the Homestead depart on every half-hour (except 12:30pm) from 9:30am until 4:30pm, leaving from the porch at the Homestead. Please check-in with the Visitor's Center on College Street. No charge for admission.
